

- **ORGANISER AND LOCATION**
 - Romanian Modelling Federation in cooperation with the City Council of Buzău and the Buzau Space Modelling Association.
 - The field will be the same that it was used for most of the International Championships held in Buzau and also for all internal space models events in the last 10 years.
 - The field is very well known among Space Models flyers and is situated 10 km away from Buzau, on the road from Buzau to Bucharest. The coordinates for contest site are: 45°03'39.6"N 26°46'26.8"E .
 - Weather forecast at the end of October is usually good for Space Models Classes with an average daily temperature of 19-21°C and moderate wind speed of 21-25 km/h and no more than a short summer rain weekly.

- **RULES**

The championship will be run according to:

- FAI Sporting Code, Section 4, CIAM General Rules and Volume Space Models, Edition January 01, 2021.
- FAI General Section and FAI Code of Ethics.

Anti-Doping Statement:

If a competitor has to take, by a medical condition, any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

Quotation from the FAI anti-doping regulations: “If you regularly take medication prescribed by your doctor and this medication is on the WADA prohibited list, you need to get a form called a TUE (therapeutic use exemption) filled out by your doctor. International level athletes must send the form to the FAI Secretariat, national level athletes send it to their National Air Sport Control”.

FAI Sporting Licence: each competitor and team manager must possess a FAI Sporting Licence valid for the year of the championship. This licence must be registered in the FAI licences database.

Note: The holder of a FAI Sporting Licence may be required to produce an official document bearing his photograph and signature as proof of identity.

Protest: any protest must be presented in writing to the Contest Director and must be accompanied by the deposit of a fee of 50 Euros. The deposit is returned only if the protest is upheld.

- **MEASUREMENT OF FLIGHT ALTITUDE:**

The organizer shall provide electronic altimeters for all entrants in the altitude classes S1A, S1B, S5B and S5C.

Every team shall submit, at registration, a deposit for each altimeter that will be issued. The deposit must be paid before the contest start. The deposit shall be an amount of 80 Euro and shall be returned when the altimeters and batteries are returned. If an altimeter or battery is not returned, or is damaged, the deposit shall be retained. If all altimeters per team are lost, during a competition, a new deposit must be paid to allow the team to continue participating in the competition.

- **COMPOSITION OF A NATIONAL TEAM**

Each National Aero-club/National Federation, member of the FAI-CIAM may enter a team consisting of:

- team manager, team manager assistant
- senior competitors: maximum 3 competitors or a maximum of 4 competitors if at least one competitor is female;
- junior competitors (age limit 18 years in the year 2021 except for juniors registered for 2020 FAI S WCh who have exceeded this age): maximum 3 competitors or a maximum of 4 competitors if at least one competitor is female;
- according to the FAI Sporting Code, the reigning senior World Champion
- according to the FAI Sporting Code, the reigning junior World Champion (referring to the CIAM General Rule 2021; sections C.5.1 and C.5.3. d);
- official helpers, supporters.

- **CLASSIFICATION AND AWARDS**

Individual classification:

FAI medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the competitors seniors and juniors placed first, second and third.

All senior Females will compete for the overall senior individual classification.

Additionally, there is a senior Female classification both with FAI medals and diplomas.

All Junior Females will compete for the overall junior individual classification.

Additionally, there is a junior Female classification both with FAI medals and diplomas.

FAI medals and diplomas will be awarded to the first, second and third overall juniors. If only one or two overall juniors, compete in the class, they shall be awarded an FAI medal and diploma.

FAI medals and diplomas will be awarded to the first, second and third placed females, junior or senior. If only one or two females, junior or senior, compete in the class, they shall be awarded an FAI medal and diploma.

In order to award the title of Junior World Champion, junior competitors from at least four nations must participate.

In order to award the title of Senior Female World Champion, senior female competitors from at least four nations must participate.

In order to award the title of Junior Female World Champion, junior female competitors from at least four nations must participate.

The reigning World Champion 2018 (subject to the approval of his NAC) to participate in the championship(s) in that class regardless of whether or not he qualifies for the national team. If he is not a member of the national team, his score or place will not be considered in the team results.

01st of September - 15th of September: 10% fine

15th of September - 02th of October: 20% fine

The bank commission is in charge of sender.

- **BOARD AND LODGING**

At the request of the organizer, the prices for the accommodation of the foreign delegations participating in the competition were reduced. In these hotels the organizer ensures the observance of all the rules for the prevention of Sars-CoV-2 infection and the costs of testing (during the competition) and isolation in case of infection of the persons accommodated here will be borne by the organizer.

The Organizer can provide board and lodging in Buzău, in **Hotel AVENUE 4****** and **Hotel PIETROASA 4****** - 50 EURO/pers/day (double rooms with bath room, Tv, wi-fi, possibility of whirlpool, sauna, fitness room.), and in **Hotel B90 3***** - 40 EURO/pers/day (double rooms with bath room, Tv, wi-fi). Prices include breakfast and dinner in hotel restaurants. In this case, the organizer provides free transport from the airport to the hotel and from the hotel to the contest site.

The Organizer will provide lunch on the contest site for 10 Euro per day for each person. **For your health and safety of all participants in the competition, please do not choose other accommodation spaces that are not monitored by the organizer. Otherwise you will be directly responsible for the consequences of the choice you make.**

- **Banquet**

50 EURO/senior; 40 EURO/junior.

- **INSURANCE**

The organizer will provide a limited third-party liability insurance covering all competitors for model accidents involving injury to others and damage to property. It is recommended that individual health and travel insurance is purchased before travelling.

For EU citizens, health care is covered under Social Health Care on presentation of an EU 11 form available in the country of residence.

Citizens from outside of EU should provide their own health insurance to cover illness and travel insurance.

The Organizers are not responsible for any kind of PERSONAL injury, loss, theft or damage to people or property OUTSIDE OF THE COMPETITION.

The Organizers will cover third party damage during the contest.

- **COVID-19 information**

On August 1 the situation of COVID-19 in Romania is very good, the incidence rate is less than 0.06 per thousand inhabitants. 5 million Romanians were immunized, exceeding 25% of the population.

Also, as provided in the Protocol sent to the FAI-CIAM Bureau for approval, the organizer will take all measures to ensure that this championship takes place safely (for correct and complete information, find the document on the competition website) .

However, to avoid any possibility of infection as well as periodic testing, our recommendation is to be vaccinated. If all participants are vaccinated, we have no restrictions during championships, banquets or leisure.

Depending on the evolution of the COVID-19 situation in the world, it may be necessary for each person participating in the World Championships to respect the special hygiene rules. The organizer will monitor the situation and publish the appropriate recommendations in a timely manner.

According to the current internal regulations of Romania, the members of the sports delegations arriving in Romania to participate in sports competitions organized on the national territory, from countries in the red zone of epidemiological risk are exempted from the quarantine measure established according to the provisions of this decision an

RT-PCR test for SARS-CoV-2 infection performed no later than 72 hours before entering the country and participating only in activities within the mentioned competitions.

- **Visa requirements**

For those countries where the Romanian Entry Visa is asked for, it can be obtained from The Romanian Embassies/Consulates. For more information please consult the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. (www.mae.ro/en/node/2040)

Citizens belonging to the countries members of EU do not need an Entry Visa.

- **Registration of the national teams**

On registration, the Team Manager must present the FAI licences, an updated entry form (if any changes), a national flag (1m x 1,5m), national anthem on memory stick, and the payment order only if paid late.

- **Transportation**

The organizer will provide transport for teams at their request, from “Henri Coanda” Bucharest International airport to Buzau.
